

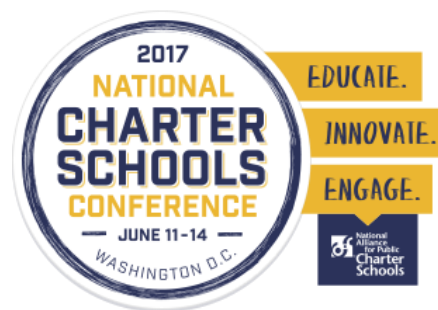


PEER-TO-PEER ROUNDTABLE CTE CHARTER SCHOOLS

An inward-facing roundtable – participants only, no audience – brought together 20 educators and administrators from charter schools offering career and technical education: both full-fledged CTE charters and academically focused schools that offer CTE courses and work-based-learning experience.

The goal of the session: to create a forum for participants to compare notes, identify common problems, brainstorm about solutions and discuss public policy.

The final session of the half-day roundtable explored what kinds of support participants would find helpful going forward. Among their answers: regular meetings, regional meetings, policy briefs and an online forum,
