KENNETH ADAMS

Kenneth Adams is president of LaGuardia Community College. Before joining LaGuardia, he was dean of workforce and economic development at Bronx Community College and, before that, president and CEO of Empire State Development and commissioner of the New York State Department of Economic Development. He is chairman of the boards of directors of New York State's affordable housing agencies.

FARHAD ASGHAR

Farhad Asghar is a program officer with the Carnegie Corporation of New York, where he manages the pathways to postsecondary success portfolio. Before joining Carnegie, he was executive director of community partnerships for the College Board's Access to Opportunity program and, before that, an associate vice president of Bank Street College of Education. Earlier in his career, he taught English in a Brooklyn public high school.

Stephen Fagen is director of early career programs and strategic partnerships on the American Express technology talent excellence team. He was previously chief of staff to the executive vice president of technology risk and information security at American Express. Before that, he served as chief of staff at the New York City Department of Information Technology and Telecommunications, which oversees the city's 9-1-1 and 3-1-1 systems.
