PAUL FAIN

Paul Fain helped found the weekly publication *Work Shift* and writes *The Job*, a newsletter about connections between education and work. He was previously a reporter and editor at *Inside Higher Ed* and *The Chronicle of Higher Education*.

GLENN HUBBARD

Glenn Hubbard is dean emeritus and Russell L. Carson Professor of Finance and Economics at Columbia Business School. He served previously as deputy assistant secretary at the US Department of the Treasury and chairman of the Council of Economic Advisers. He is author of several books, including most recently, *Balance: The Economics of Great Powers from Ancient Rome to Modern America*.

TAMAR JACOBY

Tamar Jacoby is president of Opportunity America. A former journalist and author, she was a senior writer and justice editor at *Newsweek* and, before that, the deputy editor of the *New York Times* op-ed page. She is the author of *Someone Else's House: America's Unfinished Struggle for Integration*.

HARRISON KELLER

Harrison Keller is the commissioner of higher education for the state of Texas. He served previously at the University of Texas at Austin, where he was deputy to the president for strategy and policy and vice provost for higher education policy and research. Before that, he was director of research for the Texas House of Representatives.

ANNE KRESS

Anne Kress is president of Northern Virginia Community College. She served previously as president of Monroe Community College and sits on numerous boards, including Jobs for the Future's Policy Trust and the American Association of Community Colleges board of directors.

CHAUNCY LENNON

Chauncy Lennon is vice president for the future of learning and work at Lumina Foundation. Before joining Lumina, he was a managing director and leader of workforce strategy at JPMorgan Chase & Co. and, before that, a program officer at the Ford Foundation. He serves on the New York City Workforce Development Board.

KIM HUNTER REED

Kim Hunter Reed is the Louisiana commissioner of higher education. She served previously as executive director of the Colorado Department of Higher Education and, before that, as deputy undersecretary at the US Department of Education. Earlier in her career, she was deputy commissioner for public affairs for the Louisiana Board of Regents and executive vice president of the University of Louisiana System.
